RPD and DCVA... its more than alphabet soup!


The full name for these popular acronyms is **Reduced Pressure Principle Backflow Preventer and Double Check Valve Assembly**. Backflow prevention is serious business when protecting the public drinking water supply. These protective devices have long guarded "City Water" systems from becoming contaminated by consumers. Without such devices, toxic materials could be drawn into water supply lines by periodic drops in line pressure. Toxic substances from connected users, could easily be drawn back into the supply lines, thereby contaminating "down stream" feeds, as normal line pressure is resumed.



Here in Connecticut, attention has recently turned to protecting older vulnerable fire sprinkler water feeds with DCVA's. According to the Regulations of Connecticut State Agencies, Public Health Code 2000, all existing and new sprinkler systems must have anti-siphon backflow prevention. Specifically 19-13B38a (C) (I) of the CT Public Health Code set forth January 1, 1999 as the deadline to retrofit older existing fire systems.
